

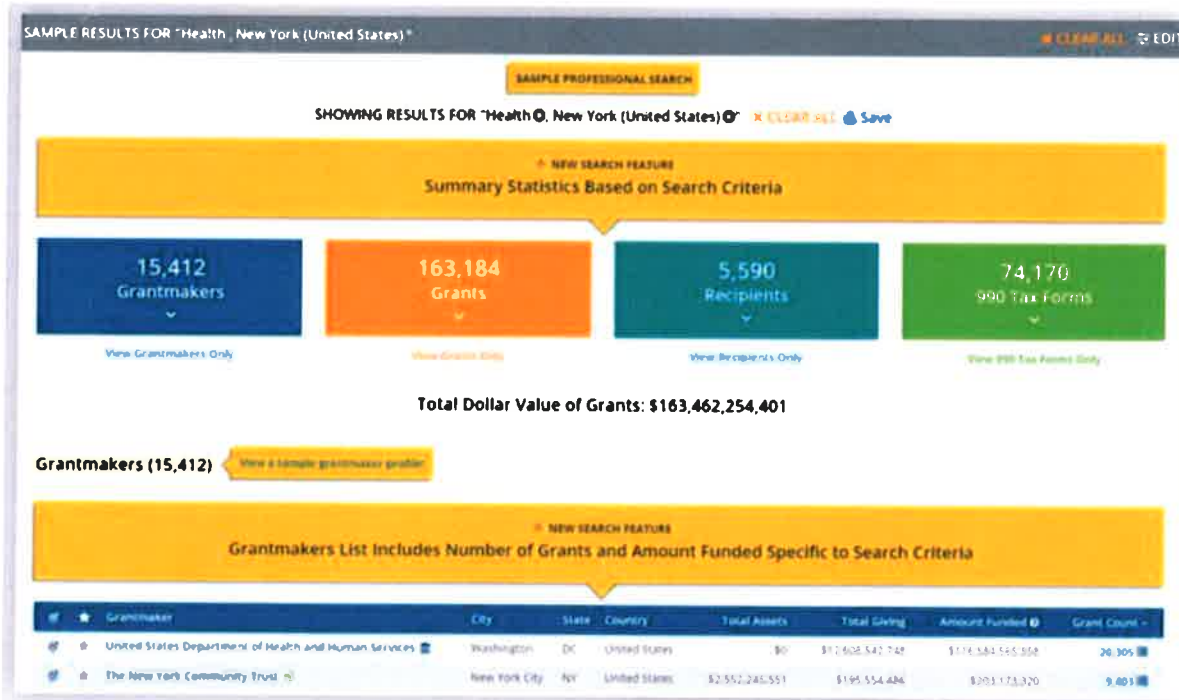
Foundation Center

Foundation Center maintains the most comprehensive database on U.S. and, increasingly, global grantmakers and their grants—a robust, accessible knowledge bank for the sector. It also operates research, education, and training programs designed to advance knowledge of philanthropy at every level.

Foundation Directory Online (FDO) simplifies the process via:

- A through database, comprised of more than 140,000 grantmakers;
- Multiple filters and an assessment tool to quickly allow identification of the best potential funding sources; and
- A prospect management platform that automates much of the grantseeking process, including storing application data.
